Phonics

Please look through the phonics packs sent home this week. The children have been brilliant picking these up in Year 1. Can they say the sound without looking at the word on the back? Watch out for digraphs and trigraphs that make different sounds e.g. 'ear' can make 'ear' as in dear and 'air' as in dare.

Reading

Please spend some time every day reading and talking about your book.

Purple Mash and MyMaths

The children have used Purple Mash in class and have been introduced to MyMaths this week. Take some time looking at both and become familiar with how it works. Locate the activities set for Year 1.

Maths

This week the topic is 'Capacity'. Ask your child to explore this in a practical way using a variety of containers. Encourage to use language to compare the volume for example full, empty, half full, greater than half and less than half. This can be a fun activity in the garden, at the kitchen sink or even at bath time! Using a smaller container such as a cup, estimate the capacity of the larger containers i.e. guess how many cups (using the same non-standard measure each time) will fill each and then find out if they were right.

My Maths: Counting 1 and Money 1

Continuing to count in 2s,5s and 10s informally would be great.

English

This week the topic is 'instructions'.

Activity 1: Look at the 2do set on **Purple Mash**: Smoothie recipe sequence

Activity 2: Look at these verbs: **walk, bury, climb, sail**. In your English book write sentences about pirates using these verbs (action words).

Activity 3: In your English book, design (draw) a treasure chest for a pirate. What will you put in? Draw and label the items with adjectives e.g. shin, gold coins.

Activity 4: Write instructions for a pirate under the title **How to hide treasure**.

Start each instruction with a bossy verb e.g.

1. Sail to a desert island.

2. Dig a deep hole in the sand with a spade.

Art/ICT

Create your own family pirate flag to hang on a wall or door. You could do this as an art activity on paper or you could use **Purple Mash 2Do: Flag**. If you do this as an art activity you could send us a photo.

Music/ICT - 2Sequence in Purple Mash.

Create your own music sequence and then play it again and again to your parents (*but stop when they say they have had enough!*)
