English - Reading

- Read for up to 30 minutes, a minimum of three times a week.

English – Writing

Learning this week is focused around the animation 'Ruckus' <https://vimeo.com/68344409>.

It is important to follow the activities in order as they build on each other. All activities / resources are on Seesaw.

- **English 1:** Watch the film and answer the comprehension questions.
- **English 2:** Complete a character profile for one of the brothers.
- **English 3:** Create a wanted poster for one of the brothers. Use your character profile plans as you have already done most of the hard work!
- **English 4:** The clip has no speech. Imagine that the brothers were talking to each other throughout the ruckus- what do you think they would say? What would the tone/atmosphere be like? Write the conversation between them using speech bubbles as they chase each other for the diamond.
- **English 5:** Watch the video about setting out direct speech; then turn speech bubbles from activity 4 into direct speech.

Maths

Try to complete the Maths tasks in the order listed. They are numbered. All activities / resources are on Seesaw.

- **Maths 1:** Log onto Times Tables Rock Stars and complete Sound Check challenge
- **Maths 2:** Complete the MyMaths activities on money
- **Maths 3:** Watch the video about solving problems using money then complete the questions. Don't worry if you do not manage to get to end, just do as many as can.
- **Maths 4:** Use a ruler, metre stick and/or tape measure and measure the length of different objects around your house and garden. Record each measurement in centimetres and then in metres.
- **Activity 5:** Complete the Flashback 4 questions.

- thoughts and feelings
- past tense

Activity 2: Viking Art

Look at animals in Viking art (search online for the Urnes or Jellinge styles). Can you design and draw an imaginary beast to make a fantastic pattern?
