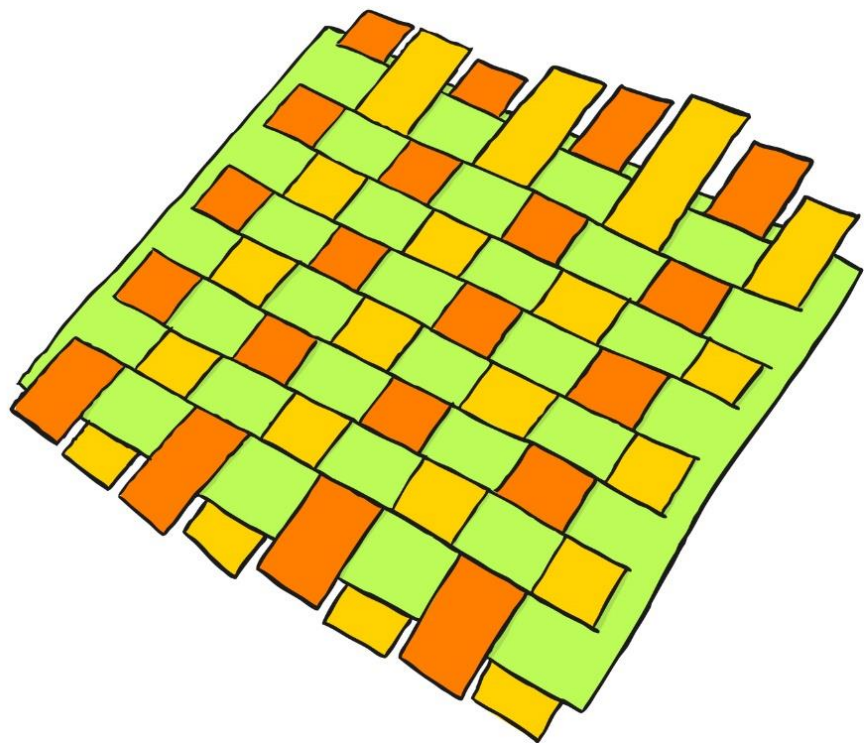
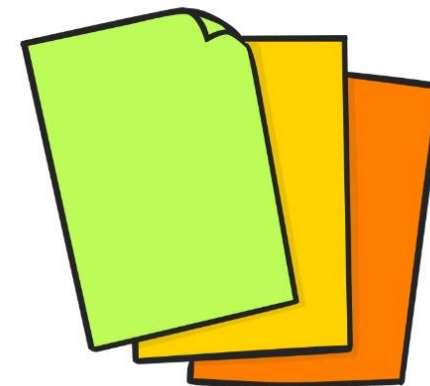
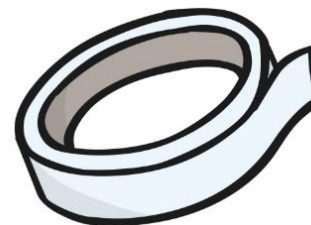
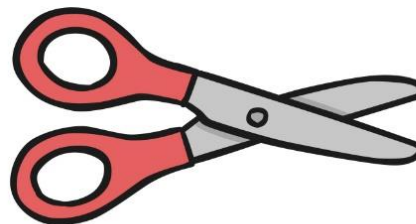


How to...



Weave Paper



Materials and equipment:

Scissors

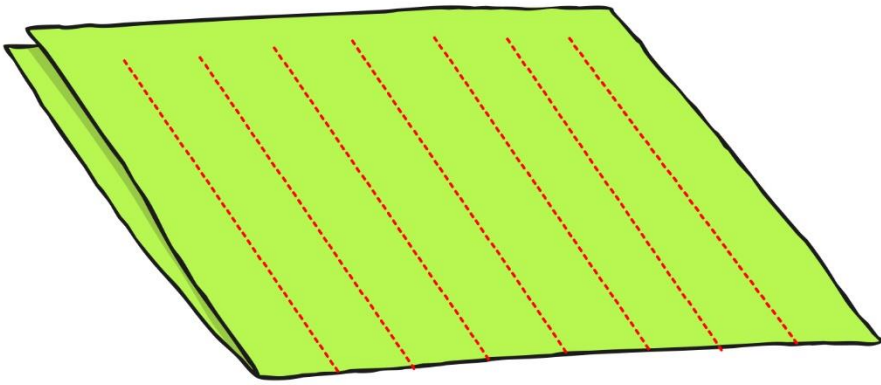
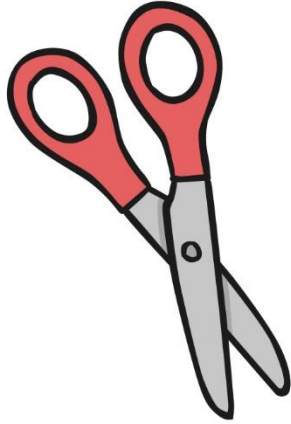
Glue stick

Pencil

Coloured paper

Sticky tape

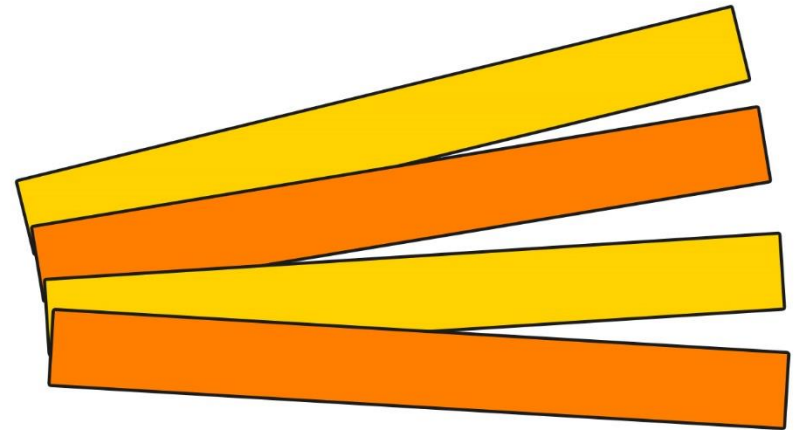
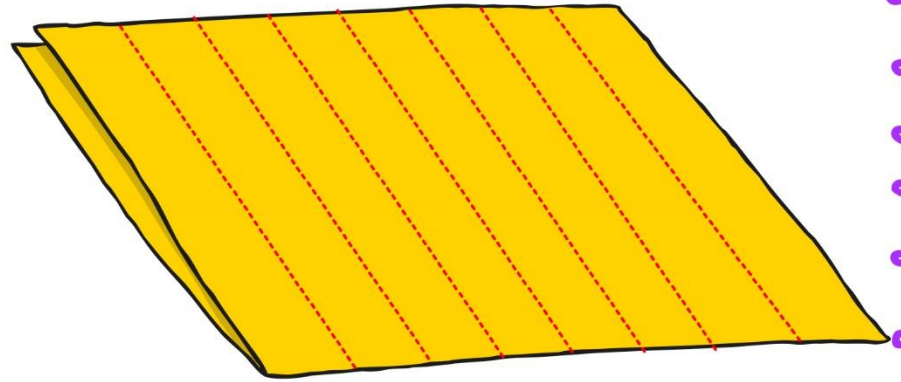

First, fold a piece of paper in half and cut slices into it.

Be careful not to cut all the way through it and leave about an inch of the edge.

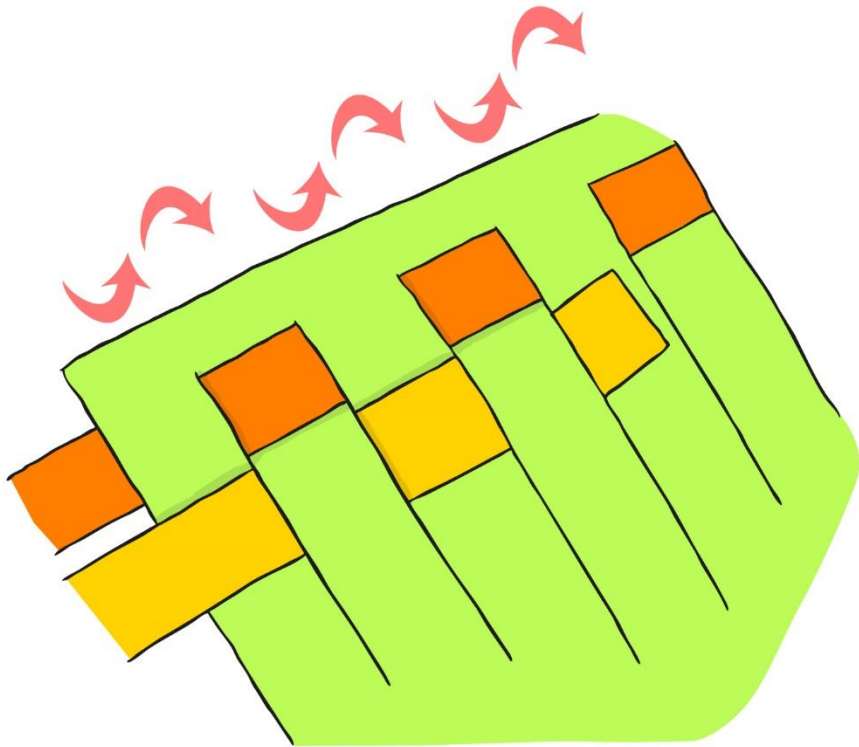

Next, cut complete strips of the same width from a second piece of paper. Use 2 colours of paper if you wish. If you draw some lines first so your child gets the idea of where to cut.



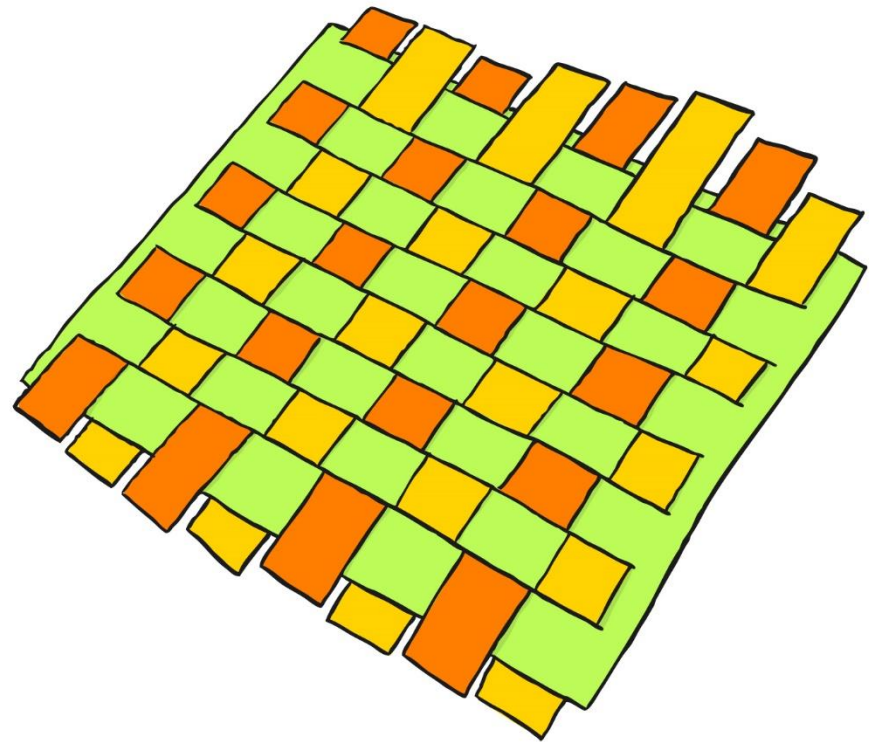

Now thread the strips into the piece of paper you have sliced, by weaving in and out.

Do this until your whole piece of paper has been weaved.

Glue or tape the edges so that the strips of paper don't slip out.

You can try using your woven paper to decorate cards or even diaries
