Y3 Induction arrangements September 2020

Dear parents and carers,

We are very mindful that many of the children currently in Y2 have had many months away from schools and will need to gradually re-build their confidence and stamina when they return in September. As children also join our school at Y3 from many other schools we feel it is very important to give them a positive start to their time in Key Stage 2. With that in mind we have planned a slower start for the children on the first day back; Thursday 3rd September. We have also had to ensure we are minimising the risk of the spread of the COVID-19 virus by staggering times that families arrive and leave school; avoiding crowding at the school gates. We are aware that it may be tricky for parents to tie in their own work commitments with our plans but hope you understand the importance of the children having the most positive start to their time at this school as possible.

Thursday 3rd September

Children to arrive at school after all the children in other classes have arrived. We invite one parent to bring their child into school via the wooden gate by the drive. (We would ask that only one parent comes along and ideally without a younger sibling.) Parents will be able to come onto the site and drop their child at the classroom door. We will then ask you to leave by the far pedestrian gate.

Please arrive between the times below

9:30 – 9:45 Children with a surname starting with the letters A – G

9:45 – 10:00 Children with a surname starting with the letters H – M

10:00 – 10:15 Children with a surname starting with the letters N - Z

At the end of the day children in Y3 will finish earlier and can be picked up between 2:20 and 2:40. Parents may again come onto the playground via the wooden gate and collect their child from the classroom.

From Friday 4th September drop off and pick up will be as described in the September information letter sent to all parents.

We hope this shorter day for our Y3 pupils will give them a positive start to their time at William Cobbett. As it will be harder to talk with teacher face to face the best way to communicate any information about your child will be by emailing their teacher.
